ESSENTIAL QUALIFICATIONS

PROFESSOR :

An eminent scholar with published work of high quality, actively engaged in research, with 10 years experience in post-graduate teaching, and/or experience in research at the University/National Level institutions, including experience of guiding research at doctoral level.

OR

An outstanding scholar with established reputation who has made significant contribution to knowledge.

READER :

Good academic record with a doctoral degree or equivalent published work. In addition to these, candidates who join from outside the university system shall also possess at least 55% of the marks or an equivalent grade of B in the 7 point scale with letter grades O, A, B, C, D and E & F at the Master's degree level.

Five years of experience of teaching and/or research excluding the period spent for obtaining the research degrees and has made some mark in the areas of scholarship as evidenced by quality of publications, contribution to educational innovation, design of new courses and curricula.

READER - JOURNALISM AND MASS COMMUNICATION

- (i) Ph.D. degree in communication/Mass Communication/Journalism from an Indian University or an equivalent degree from a foreign University.

Or

Published work of doctoral standard or media production work of excellence.

- (ii) Good academic record with at least 55% marks (or an equivalent grade) at Master's level in the subject.

- (iii) Eight years of experience of teaching and/or research including upto three years for research degree and having made a mark in the areas of scholarship as evidenced by quality of publications, contribution to educational innovation, design of new courses and curricula.

Or

10 years full time work experience in any area of Mass Communication (Newspaper accredited with ABC, National News Agencies, radio or television, film media, reputed advertising agencies, Public Relation Officers of the Government, Public Sector undertaking and established Industrial and Commercial Houses).

LECTURER :

Good academic record with at least 55% of the marks or, an equivalent grade of B in the 7 point scale with letter grades O, A, B, C, D, E & F at the Master's degree level, in the relevant subject from an Indian University, or, an equivalent degree from a foreign University.

Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, candidates should have cleared the eligibility test (NET) for lecturers conducted by the UGC, CSIR or similar test accredited by the UGC.

NET shall remain the compulsory requirement for appointment as Lecturer for those with post-graduate degree. However, the candidates having Ph.D. degree in the concerned subject are exempted from NET for PG and UG level teaching. The candidates having M.Phil degree in the concerned subject are exempted from NET for UG level teaching only.

RELAXATION

A relaxation of 5% may be provided from 55% to 50% of the marks at the Master's level for SC/ST Category.
